RATE SCHEDULE I COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL SERVICE

AVAILABILITY

This Schedule is applicable to any commercial or industrial consumer contracting to pay for a peak demand of 1500 KW or more of alternating current electricity.

TYPE OF SERVICE

Three-phase service at standard secondary voltages may be provided in those instances where its usage will not be detrimental to the service of other consumers. Such service is available at standard primary voltages where the consumer's service is metered on the primary side of the consumer owned secondary transformer.

Electric Supply Energy charges are subject to the Power Cost Adjustment Rider as filed under Rate Schedule C.

DISCOUNT FOR METERING AT PRIMARY VOLTAGE

The demand and energy charges will be reduced by 3% when service is taken at primary voltage and the consumer owns and maintains all equipment on the load side of the meter.

DETERMINATION OF MAXIMUM DEMAND

The maximum demand shall be the maximum kilowatt load used by the consumer for any fifteen (15) consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered as indicated or recorded by a maximum demand meter or lagged thermal demand meter installed by the Cooperative or as adjusted for power factor, whichever is the greater.

DETERMINATION OF MAXIMUM RKVA DEMAND

The maximum rkVA demand shall be the maximum reactive kilovolt ampere load used by the consumer for any fifteen (15) consecutive minutes during the month for which the bill is rendered as indicated or recorded by a maximum demand meter or lagged thermal demand meter installed by the Cooperative.

MINIMUM CHARGES

The monthly minimum charge shall be the Metering and Billing Charge plus the Distribution Basic Service Charge plus the Facilities Charge, if any.

TERM OF CONTRACT

The term of contract for the purchase of distribution service under this Schedule shall be such as may be mutually agreed upon, but for not less than five years.
